













1. BAF-001, His Royal Navy Dress Regulations is issued on authority of the First Sea Lord.

6. Suggestions for changes shall be directed to First Sea Lord.

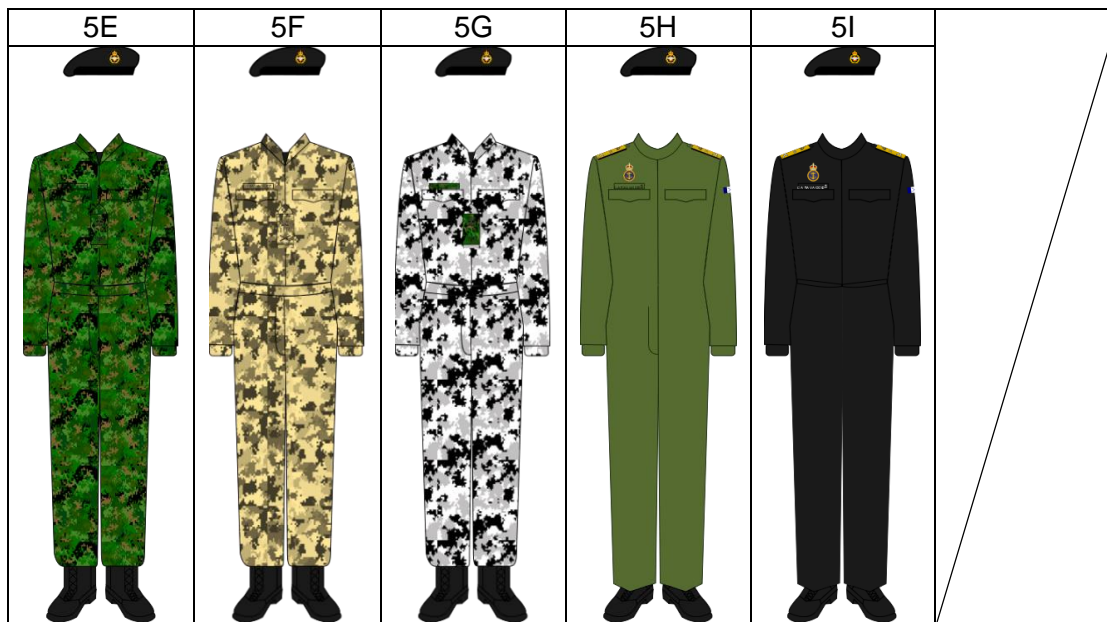


