## **INTERPERATION OF MILITARY DOCUMENTS**

1. "Shall, and will" shall be construed as being imperative.
2. "May" shall be construed as being permissive.
3. "Should" shall be construed as being informative.

## **NUMBERING OF HIS ROYAL NAVY DOCUMENTS**

4. His Royal Navy documents shall be numbered commencing with 'BAF-0.'
5. Two numbers shall follow indicating the document number in chronological order.

## **NUMBERING OF HIS ROYAL ARMY DOCUMENTS**

6. His Royal Army documents shall be numbered commencing with 'BAF-1.'
7. Two numbers shall follow indicating the document number in chronological order.

## **NUMBERING OF BAUSTRALIAN ARMED FORCES DOCUMENTS**

8. Baustralian Armed Forces documents shall be numbered commencing with 'BAF-2.'
12. Two numbers shall follow indicating the document number in chronological order.
13. Should the document be informative, e.g. drill instruction, the second number shall be '0' or '1.'
14. Should the document be administrative, e.g. orders, the second number shall be '2' or '3.'
  - a. Should the document be a KR&O document, the second number shall be '4' or '5.'
15. Should the document be regulations, the second number shall be '6' or '7.'
16. Else, the second number shall be '7,' '8,' or '9.'

## **NUMBERING OF HIS ROYAL AIR FORCE DOCUMENTS**

17. His Royal Air Force documents shall be numbered commencing with 'BAF-3.'
18. Two numbers shall follow indicating the document number in chronological order.

## **RESERVED NUMBERS**

19. Commencing numbers '4,' and '9' are reserved.

## **SUPPLEMENTARY DOCUMENTS**

20. His Royal Marines documents shall be numbered commencing with 'BAF-5.'
21. His Royal Coast Guard documents shall be numbered commencing with 'BAF-6.'
22. His Royal Land Customs documents shall be numbered commencing with 'BAF-7.'
23. His Royal Air Customs documents shall be numbered commencing with 'BAF-8.'
24. For each of the supplementary documents two numbers shall follow indicating the document number in chronological order, then succeeded with 'S.'
